
SUMMER GILLIAM

The Tuskegee Airman and uncle of the Detroit Cobbs, whom many Huguely family members met during the 2006 reunion in Detroit, is the subject of a new, outstanding feature-length documentary film titled, "Luft Gangter: Memoirs of a Second Class Citizen," which is based on his 2005 book, "Red Tail Captured, Red Tail Free: Memoirs of a Tuskegee Airman and POW." Mike Rott, the producer/director and independent filmmaker based just outside Detroit, met 'Uncle Alex' four years ago at a speaking engagement where Uncle Alex discussed his book, the Tuskegee Airmen, and his experiences as a prisoner of war (POW). The film has already garnered two very prestigious awards: (a) 2014 Los Angeles International Underground Film Festival – Best Documentary Feature and (b) 2015 Albuquerque Film & Music Experience – Audience Choice Award.





On October 16th, two sold-out private screenings of the completed film were held at the Riviera Cinemas outside Detroit. The Cobbs and Coffees (cousins) turned out in great numbers.
