#### Old Business

2015 Lexington Reunion Planning Status—Mike Runyon reported the upcoming reunion would have an "Ol' School" theme. A "Taste of LexKin" will take place of Friday evening at the host hotel. The family will gather at Jacobson Park on Saturday for a picnic catered by Chef Bam Bam. A live band has been secured for the dance at the host hotel on Saturday evening. The host hotel will be Comfort Inn Suites on Buena Vista in Lexington, Ky. 20 rooms have been blocked off at a rate of \$85.00/night (single/double) and \$95.00/night (suite).

Scholarship Committee—Del Gillispie reported that the deadline for applying for scholarship is July 1, 2015, and applicants must submit a transcript with their application. The committee proposed increasing the GPA requirement to 2.75, an increase from 2.5. The scholarship committee also suggests recipients must agree to serve as a mentor on the Huguely mentoring program. Acceptance of this report was moved by Vickie Mitchell and seconded by Kenneth Cobb.

He purchased a software program, Family Tree Maker. This will be available on the Huguely website. Currently, 1402 names are on the family database, and the family tree and branches are updated.

<u>Huguely Documents/Depository</u>—Kenneth is collaborating with Gerry Hughley and Randall Cobb to implement and update via the Huguely website. There is a cost of \$18.00/year to obtain a domain name for the website.
