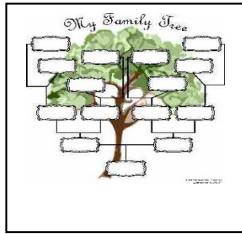

Huguely Family Reunion Scholarship Guidelines



Purpose

The Huguely Reunion Scholarship Program was established to provide college tuition assistance to eligible high school seniors and undergraduate college students of the Reunion.

Scholarship Amount

The scholarship award is to be used for tuition assistance at an approved and accredited institution.

Eligibility Requirements

The students of the Huguely Reunion are eligible for the award if they meet all of the eligibility requirements below:

- The student is related to the Huguely Reunion Family by blood or/and legal adoption.
- The student is an active member of the Huguely Reunion.
- For recent high school graduates, the student must achieve a minimum 2.5 grade point average and must have been accepted to an approved and accredited institution.
- The student has been previously enrolled in college/university and has achieved a minimum 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale and must have been accepted to an approved and accredited institution.
- The student is enrolled in undergraduate college courses. **Graduate students are not eligible.**
- The student is enrolled as a full time college student.
- The student must agree to participate in the Huguely Reunion Career and College Mentoring Program for Youth and Young Adults.

Approved Institutions

Approved institutions include four-year colleges or universities, junior colleges, and vocational/technical schools who offer degreed programs.

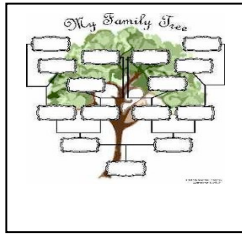
Renewal

Eligible students may apply for **renewal of the Huguely Reunion Scholarship three (3) times** after the initial award; however, they must attend college for consecutive semesters (or quarters) to be granted renewal, not including summer break (a total of 8 consecutive semesters or 16 consecutive quarters). **Students who drop out of the institution and later return are not eligible for scholarship renewal.**

Procedure

Families with eligible students must complete the attached Huguely Reunion Scholarship Award Form and submit it to the Scholarship Committee for approval by July 1st of each year. There will be no mid year entries. Upon approval, the check will be made payable to the student(s) and presented to the student(s) at the Huguely Reunion in August. Any questions regarding this policy should be directed to the Scholarship Committee.

Huguely Family Reunion Scholarship Guidelines



The Huguely reunion reserves the right to make changes to its policies at any time. The Huguely Reunion Scholarship Committee will make any interpretations or decisions regarding eligibility. Final Awards will be granted at the sole discretion of Huguely Reunion Scholarship Committee and the Executive Body.

Other

- A. There are no limits on the number of scholarship awards per family.
- B. Awards are processed once each year in July and presented at the Huguely Reunion in August.
- C. Should the student not enter the approved institution after receiving the award, the Award must be returned to the Huguely Reunion Scholarship Fund.
- D. Awardees must agree to serve as a mentor for a Huguely Family member(s) via the Mentoring Program; and must sign up upon receiving the monetary award.
