Huguely Family Reunion Scholarship Guidelines

Purpose

The purpose of the Huguely Family Reunion (Huguely Reunion) Scholarship Program is to provide eligible high school seniors and undergraduate college students of the Reunion with tuition assistance for an approved and accredited institution.

Scholarship Amount

The scholarship award is to be used solely for tuition assistance or other college expenses at approved and accredited institutions.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the Huguely Reunion Scholarship, students must meet the following criteria:

- A. The student must be related to the Huguely Reunion Family by blood and/or legal adoption.
- B. The student must be an active member of the Huguely Reunion.
- C. For recent high school graduates, the student must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and have been accepted to an approved and accredited institution.
- D. For students previously enrolled in college/university, the student must have a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale and have been accepted to an approved and accredited institution.
- E. The student must be enrolled in undergraduate college courses. Graduate students are not eligible.
- F. The student must be enrolled as a full-time college student.
- G. The student must agree to participate in the Huguely Reunion Career and College Mentoring Program for Youth and Young Adults.

Approved Institutions

Approved institutions include four-year colleges or universities, community colleges, and vocational/technical schools offering degreed programs.

Renewal

Eligible students may apply for renewal of the Huguely Reunion Scholarship up to three (3) times after the initial award. To be granted renewal, they must attend college for consecutive semesters (or quarters), not including summer breaks, for a total of eight (8) consecutive semesters or sixteen (16) consecutive quarters and maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale. Students who drop out of the institution and later return are not eligible for scholarship renewal.

Procedure

Eligible students must complete the attached Huguely Family Reunion Scholarship Award Form and submit it to the Scholarship Committee for approval by July 1st of each year. No mid-year entries will be accepted. Upon approval, scholarship recipients must submit verification of enrollment in a college/university before disbursement of Scholarship funds. Recipients will receive scholarship funds once appropriate documentation is provided. Any questions regarding this policy should be directed to the Scholarship Committee. The Huguely Reunion reserves the right to amend its policies at any time. The

Huguely Reunion Scholarship Committee will make any interpretations or decisions regarding eligibility. Final awards will be granted at the sole discretion of the Huguely Reunion Scholarship Committee and the Executive Body.

Other

- A. There is no limit on the number of scholarship awards per family.
- B. Awardees will be recognized once a year and presented at the annual Huguely Reunion.
- C. If the student does not enter the approved institution after receiving the award, the award must be returned to the Huguely Reunion Scholarship Fund.
- D. Awardees must agree to serve as a mentor for a Huguely Family member(s) via the Mentoring Program and sign up upon receiving the monetary award.
